German Made, German Quality

Our German manufacturer has submitted this range of kitchens to safety inspections by LGA QualiTest GmbH's testing and certification centre, and the GS test mark confirms that this range of kitchens meets all requirements for safety, load-bearing, material consistency and ease of use. The GS mark also confirms that our German manufacturer is regularly subjected to third-party monitoring, which ensures that the requirements for new products and developments are also met without fail.

Our German manufacturer has submitted this range of kitchens for formaldehyde testing. With PURemission, all wooden products of our range comply with the high US-American standards regarding permissible formaldehyde threshold values from now on and will once more at the same time undercut clearly the European specifications. Through a careful selection of timber materials and suppliers, our German manufacturer has managed to comply with the emissions guidelines according to CARB2 93120 and TSCA title 6. The maximum values of the European guidelines for emission class E1 are adhered to or rather significantly undercut. All used materials are destined and suitable for the application of home furniture/kitchen furniture. The materials are subject to continuous monitoring. They are free from pesticides and insecticides. Also our German manufacturer is not aware of any other harmful emissions. The production of the kitchens takes place according to industrial methods and standards.

Our German manufacturer's products use PUResist water protection system. They have changed the bonding of their formed edges of fronts, carcass parts and surrounding materials and focused on improved technology, based on a physical/chemical setting of the adhesive to strengthen the grip between the engineered wood and the edge and give optimal protection against ingress of moisture.



QUALITY

The “Golden M” quality mark is an award for tested furniture that meets strict criteria in terms of quality, safety and health / environmental protection. The “Golden M” is awarded by the Deutsche Gütegemeinschaft Möbel eV (DGM), which as an RAL quality association has an important task: to ensure the quality of furniture and to intensify consumer protection. Furniture manufacturers have to meet very high requirements for the seal to be awarded. The strict test criteria are based on current quality, environmental and emission standards. They are primarily concerned with the durability, stability and manufacturing quality of the products. In addition, pollutant emissions and safety are thoroughly examined. The quality mark is only given to furniture that meets all requirements to full satisfaction, with proven quality.



An emission label provides the consumer with information on pollutant emission and is supposed to protect the consumer against health hazards. Classification is proven based on relevant pollutant tests. The label is exclusively awarded by the Deutsche Gütegemeinschaft Möbel e.V. Emission class A complies with the requirements of limit values in accordance with RAL-GZ 430 and/or the requirements of the Blue Angel RAL-UZ 38 (wood-based materials), RAL-UZ 117 (upholstered furniture) and/or RAL-UZ 119 (mattresses). Annual reviews in the first three years, afterwards subsequent tests and proof every two years. Having met all award requirements, our German manufacturer’s kitchens were awarded the highest emissions class of A by the Deutschen Gütegemeinschaft Möbel e.V. (German quality control association).



Our German Manufacturer is certified in accordance with PEFC (Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification Schemes). It certifies their dedication to an environment worth living in as well as responsibility in handling the valuable raw material wood. Since the derived timber products processed all come from sustainably managed forests and controlled sources. Forest certification provides the guarantee that the wood products that consumers purchase are not coming from questionable sources nor from over-exploitation, but come from managed semi-natural forests. With the PEFC certification, our German imported kitchens demonstrates our commitment and responsibility for the protection our environment.



The Blue Angel guarantees that our German Manufacturer’s products meet high standards for environmental, health and usage properties. For a correct Blue Angel assessment, the complete life cycle must be always taken into account. Products and services labeled with the Blue Angel must meet the relevant criteria developed for every product group. In order to reflect technical developments, the German Federal Environment Agency reviews these criteria every three to four years. Thus, companies are required to make their products more and more environmentally-friendly. The products and services which are distinguished are those — when viewed holistically – which are particularly environmentally friendly and at the same time meet the high standards for occupational health and safety as well as usability.



The Red Dot Award: Product Design, whose origins date back to 1955, appraises the best products created every year. In roughly 50 categories, manufacturers and designers can enter their innovations in the competition. According to the motto “In search of good design and innovation”, the jury evaluates the entries and only awards a Red Dot to products that win them over with their high design quality. Our German Manufacturer have been awarded with the Red Dot Award – Product Design in 2018, which is a testament to the high quality of their product design.

Kitchen Culture Materials

- The support material used for the carcass, fronts or surrounding materials are made from wood composites, e.g. chipboard, MDF, which are suitable for interior fittings such as kitchens or as non-structural elements in dry areas.
- Laminate front finishes (Berlin, Uno, Munich) are laminated with decorative melamine coating on both sides and coated on 4 sides with laminate form edging. DIN 68765 melamine-coated decorative flat pressed board.
- Lacquer laminate front finishes (Berlin, Laser Soft) stand out due to a special optic, quality and manufacture. Base material is a MDF board which is coated with a polymer laminate on the front. In addition, the surface is coated with a lacquer to achieve a high surface smoothness, scratch resistance and a high level of brilliance/satin effect. The front is edged on all 4 sides with a laminate form edge.
- Laminate foiled front finishes (Lotus) use medium density fibreboard with decorative melamine coating on 1 side for all foil-wrapped fronts. The surfaces and edges are coated with low-pollutant, solvent-free dispersion adhesives. Thermoplastic adhesive foils are used (PVC/PET).
- Soft lacquer fronts (Loft) use the MDF board base material with a laminate coating on the basis of melamine resin (decorative papers impregnated with melamine resin are pressed directly with the base material) The surface and edges are smoothed, sealed, and filled in a special process before the front surface and edges are coated with soft lacquer. The back is coated with the laminate in the same color as the front.

MATERIALS



Carcass

Material thickness: 16mm for sides, shelves Laminate PVC edge (1.3mm – 1.5mm) & PUR-bonding on all front edges Laminate PVC edge (0.4mm – 0.5mm) & PUR-bonding on all horizontal and rear edges Carcass joints are made using & beechwood dowels 8.0x30.0mm, using B1 dispersion adhesives (white glue)



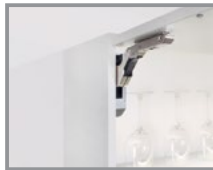
Hinge with integrated damping

No tools are required for the assembly or disassembly. By pressing a finger lightly on the concealed button, the hinge detaches in an ergonomic motion from the button and the hinge joint.



Kinematics

Minimal face joint also for doors with smaller radius. A perfect pattern of joints is achieved by the new direct-adjustment of depth and optimization of the height and depth adjustment.



Shelves & Metal Shelf supports

The shelves are always 16mm thick and directly coated particle boards (FPY/FPO) with decorative melamine coating on both sides. Melamine edging on 3 sides. PVC edges on front edges (1.5mm PP). Metal shelf supports are high load-bearing with safety pin.



Drawer & Pull-outs

Durable pull out drawer with guide rails running on soft-closing



Pinth System

Synthetic plinth feet. Plinth heights: 10cm/15cm/20cm. Plinth panels with sealing profile. Continuous, removable, fitted with clip for easy removal to clean floor and underneath units.



Flap Doors

All-metal fitting with continuous lift-up mechanism and soft dampening
Opening angle up to 107°



Soft closing

The doors close in a smooth course of motion off the reel and the automatic soft closing provides a safe closing from a closing angle of 35° onwards. Opening angle 110°



Handleless Design

Carcass handleless cut-outs for channel handles
Carcass sides will be delivered ready fitting and included in delivery (available on select photos only)



Tested quality with certificate

Excellent damping effect and long life expectancy, tested over 80,000 cycles. Full serviceability in temperature range from 5° to 40°.



Wall Unit Suspension

Full metal fitting rail
Back panels (HDF/MDF 3mm, one side finished)
3-way adjustment: height, depth, lateral Capacity: 50kg/m2 bearing area (shelves)
